Over the last several years, we have witnessed an explosion of interest in the science of judgment and decision-making. Bestsellers like Predictably Irrational and Thinking, Fast and Slow have provided engaging summaries of research on how people make choices. However, applications of this research have struggled to keep pace. This is especially true when we think about problems (and opportunities) that demand what could be termed "active decision support." Dr. Arvai will talk about research, conducted in his lab at the University of Calgary, to develop and test decision-aiding tools.
