## Join us for the 2019 Point-In-Time Homeless Street Count on Jan. 22



**What:** A one-night count to determine the number of people experiencing homelessness in Tempe and Maricopa County during a given point-in-time.

**When:** 6 a.m. – noon Jan. 22

**Where:** Throughout Tempe

### **What will volunteers do?**

Volunteers work in groups to count and interview homeless individuals in specific geographic areas of the city.

**Training:** Volunteers must attend one training session prior to the count at the Tempe Public Library, 3500 South Rural Road. **Session 1:** 10 – 11:30 a.m. Jan. 8 or **Session 2:** 6 – 7:30 p.m. Jan. 9

**Why volunteer?** Data collected helps our region better understand the widespread nature of homelessness and target critical funding and services to those most in need.
