The School of Sustainability, in response to student demand, is thrilled to present a two-day certification training in G4 – the latest version of GRI's guidelines. This certification will be of particular benefit to students interested in a corporate sustainability career and to those who may analyze or provide data, engage with stakeholders or communicate an organization's impact.

**Cost, which includes lunch, is \$200 – a fraction of the training's \$1,500 retail value.** Seats are limited to 65 students and advance registration is required.
